

CONTINENCE NURSE ADVISORS COURSES 2010



Incontinence can be a complex problem. Recent research and advances in technology have resulted in increased knowledge in this area. Practitioners are challenged to keep current with these advances and appropriately apply this new knowledge of improved clinical practice.

Aim of the Course

This continuing education course will provide Registered Nurses with the opportunity to:

- Explore current issues and practices in continence care within various settings
- Prepare for the role of Continence Nurse Advisor in the area of continence care

Course Structure and Dates

This continuing education course, designed for registered metropolitan and rural and remote nurses, will be conducted over a period of two (2) weeks from Monday 28 June - Friday 9 July 2010 (excluding Saturday and Sunday).

Program Overview:

This program prepares registered nurses to function safely and effectively as a continence nurse advisor through:

- Knowledge of practices, contextual factors and standards related to continence
- Development of therapeutic and caring relationships
- Clinical decision making
- Management of continence care of individuals and groups
- Engagement in collaborative practice.

Registration & Refunds: Registration and payment must be received 2 weeks prior to course commencing. A full refund of fees less an administration fee of 10% will be made if enrolment is cancelled in writing up to two (2) weeks prior to course commencement. After commencement of the course, if enrolment is cancelled in writing prior to the end of the second week, a refund of 50% of the course fees will be made. Minimum numbers are required to run course.

Course Credit: Participants will be awarded a Certificate and badge on completion of the course. Upon the successful completion of this course a student will be eligible for 2 credit points in the Master of Nursing Program at the University of Queensland.
